- I. Three substances were added to the list of prohibited substances to comply with legislation (Table 1 No.55 -57, and Table 3)
- II. Maximum tolerance concentration as impurities for Cadmium was reviewed. (Table 3)
- III. Maximum tolerance concentration as impurities for PFOS was reviewed. (Table 3)
- IV. Updated representative examples of No.54 in attached table.
- V. One substance is added to "Table 7 Substances whose inclusion in articles to be supplied is subject to reduction and substitution".
